

## **REPUBLIC ACT 9168**

AN ACT TO PROVIDE PROTECTION TO NEW PLANT VARIETIES, ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL PLANT VARIETY PROTECTION BOARD AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Philippine Plant Variety Protection Act of 2002



## Varieties Qualified for Protection

Certificate of Plant Variety Protection shall be granted for varieties that are: NEW, DISTINCT, UNI-FORM, and STABLE

# Who may apply for a protection?

The "breeder" can apply for a Certificate of PVP. "Breader" can be any of the following:

- 1. The person who bred, discovered and developed, a new plant variety;
- 2. Person who is the employer of the aforementioned person or who has commissioned the work:
- 3. Successors-in-interest of the foregoing persons; or
- 4. Holder of protection for the same variety in another country.

# Manner of Conducting Distinctness Uniformity and Stability (DUS) Test

Examinations of applications include a review of all available documents, publications, or other materials relating to varieties of the species involved in the application.

Grow-out test shall be done at the applicants or breeder's experimental area for two growing season.

## Term of Protection

For trees and vines, the period of protection shall be twenty-five (25) years from the date of the grant of the Certificate of Plant variety Protection and twenty (20) years from the said date for all other types of plants.
